The University of Deusto is a 125 years old HEI. Its 6 faculties, located in three campuses (Bilbao, San Sebastian and Madrid) are characterized by their capacity for both internal and external collaboration. The University of Deusto offers 23 Bachelor Degrees, 5 Double Degree, 40 Master Programmes, 12 Executive Masters, 10 Doctoral Programmes. The University of Deusto participates in more than 50 European projects annually. These include 7 Erasmus Mundus Joint Programmes, 48 Erasmus Mundus Action 2 as partner and coordinator, Marie Curie Initial Training Networks, Tempus, Lifelong Learning and FP7 projects. Also 39 highly qualified and long-time experience research groups have developed more than 1,300 research projects with different institutions and public bodies. Such various esteemed organizations and bodies have included the European Commission, Spanish Ministries, the Basque Government, Universities, Enterprises (Siemens, Iberdrola, BBVA, and Gamesa) and Foundations.

To find out your approximate Spanish level you can do an online test. All EMA2 students are offered the Intensive Spanish course (5 ECTS) and/or the Regular Spanish course (6 ECTS) by the University of Deusto free of charge at Deusto's International Spanish Center .
