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<p>The North Orissa University (NOU), established in the year 1998, is one of the youngest State and affiliating Universities of Odisha State. It is included in the UGC's list of Indian Universities under 2(f) and 12(B) and is also accredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore. The territorial jurisdiction of the University covers two tribals (Scheduled caste and Scheduled Tribes) dominating Mayurbhanj and Keonjhar districts of northern part of Odisha State. As development depends crucially upon human capital, NOU shall act as a beacon to this region so as to pull up the underprivileged youth to the national mainstream of art, culture, science and technology. The University imparts quality education at UG/PG/M. Phil./Doctoral levels. In addition, it has a well trained and experienced work force to undertake quality research through projects funded by various National Organizations and also through collaborative research programmes both in National and International levels for protecting and promoting scientific and social values. More than 100 research scholars have been pursuing research in the focused areas, in their Ph.D. programme in addition to compulsory project works undertaken by the students at UG and PG levels.</p>
